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Gearbox Ratio Calculator

Compare the original gearing fitted to your vehicle with the compatible Limebug Freeway Flyer, Super Flyer and Ultra Flyer upgrade options.

1 Select your original gearbox & tyre size

2 Compare the compatible upgrades

Select your original gearbox first to compare the compatible upgrade ratios.

3 Choose an upgrade for detailed comparison

Select your original gearbox first. Only compatible upgrades will be shown.

4 Original vs upgraded

Select an original gearbox and an upgrade to view the comparison. Original gearing Selected upgrade +0.0% at the same RPM

Lower gearing RPM can make longer journeys more relaxed while increasing road speed at the same engine RPM.

- Lower cruising RPM
- Reduced engine noise at a given road speed
- Greater road speed for the same engine RPM

Cooling notice: Lower cruising RPM also means the OEM engine cooling fan rotates more slowly. Depending on engine specification, vehicle load and how the vehicle is used, additional oil cooling may be required.

Calculation note: Results are intended as a gearing comparison guide. Actual road speed and RPM can vary slightly with tyre manufacturer, tread depth, tyre pressure, load and drivetrain tolerances.

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
